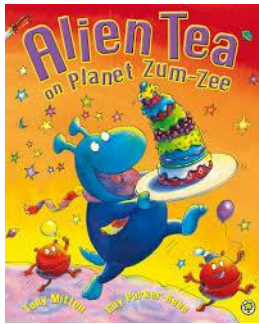


Home Learning Activities Autumn 2 Theme: **Starry Night**

Plan a trip to the moon or tea party on the moon. You could write a list or draw pictures of the items you would need to take with you or the food you want to eat. You could think about who would join you on your journey or the aliens or creatures you might meet.



Use different 2D shapes to create a name rocket.



Create a vehicle that you could use to travel into space. What would it look like? You could create a rocket using cardboard tubes, a spacecraft using old boxes or you could design a different type of vehicle to get you there!



Can you make your very own Christmas gingerbread man or another Christmas biscuit to give to your family or friends. You could even decorate them with your favourite sweets and icing.

Can you make your own salt dough Christmas decoration to go on your tree?

Salt Dough Recipe

You will need:

- 1 cup of salt
- 2 cups of plain flour
- 3/4 cup of boiling water
- Acrylic Paints
- Sealer (Varnish or PVA)

Instructions:

1. Add salt and plain flour to a bowl, gradually adding hot water.
2. Mix together till a dough forms (make sure it isn't sticky).
3. Air dry over night before putting your salt dough creations in the oven, 120 degrees for around 3 hours.
4. Allow to air dry for another day if possible to ensure the dough is fully dried out.
5. Decorate with acrylic paints and seal with varnish or PVA glue.
